The winners were-


- Folk-Dance Competition: Cadet Riya Verma stood first, Cadet Chinmay Sharma bagged the second position.


Swachhta Pakhwada





This day is widely celebrated throughout the country as Republic Day. It marks the day India's constitution finally came into force and the country became a sovereign republic.


This day is a reminder of not only the struggles of our Freedom Fighters but also of the expectations that are on us as the youth of this nation to carry this light forward.


