On 10th August 2021, the department of Commerce and Management organized a Webinar on GST: Basics & Issues.

The resource person was Manoj Louis, Assistant Professor of Commerce, GFGC Kavoor, Karnataka.

Objective: The objective of the event was to make students understand the concept of Goods and Services Tax (GST) in India.

During the webinar, Prof. Manoj Louis explained the concept of GST in detail. He discussed different types of taxes that were previously levied before the introduction of GST in India. He explained how GST is different from the previous tax structure and how GST has simplified the process and has helped in checking tax evasion.

Prof. Louis also talked about the impact of GST on manufacturing, service, and retail sector. The webinar was interactive, and participants were allowed to ask questions. The webinar was recorded and uploaded on the YouTube platform for those who could not attend the live session.

Outcomes: The students understood the difference between the old and new tax systems and what is the impact of GST on various sectors of the economy.

WORKSHOP ON RESEARCH METHODOLOGY AND DATA ANALYSIS USING JAMOVI SOFTWARE



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WORKSHOP ON "RESEARCH METHODOLOGY AND DATA ANALYSIS USING JAMOVI SOFTWARE"

The Department of Commerce & Management at St. Bede's College, Shimla, organized an online one-week workshop on "Research Methodology and Data Analysis Using JAMOVI Software" starting from October 25, 2021, in collaboration with the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC).

Objective: The workshop aimed to raise awareness about research methodology and data analysis using Jamovi software. It also aimed to provide participants with an understanding of research methodology and data analysis, with a focus on using JAMOVI software. The workshop was structured into five modules, delivered by experienced and knowledgeable faculty members.

On day one of the workshop, Professor Devender Sharma delivered a session on research methodology from a conceptual framework perspective. He talked about the meaning of research methodology, review of literature, and research design, providing the participants with an overview of the fundamental concepts of research methodology.

On day two, Dr. Devender Sharma provided a technical perspective on research methodology. He explained the procedure for research analysis, sources of data collection, and how to prepare research reports.

Day three of the workshop was focused on the concept of measurement and scales. Dr. Madhukar Dalvi discussed the basics of inferential and descriptive statistics and the types of scales, like Likert, ordinal, etc., used in research. This session was helpful for participants as it provided them with an understanding of how to measure and analyse data in research.


On day four, the participants were introduced to the Jamovi software, which is a user-friendly software for statistical analysis. Dr. Madhukar Dalvi taught the participants how to use the software in the research process and how to make hypotheses in research. This session was highly practical and provided participants with hands-on experience of using the software. Finally, on day five of the workshop, various types of parametric and non-parametric tests and their uses in research were discussed.

Outcome: The participants gained a deeper understanding of research methodology, including the conceptual framework, review of literature, research design, and technical perspective.

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




He explained the process of patent filing process and the documents needed to fill the application form.






Outcomes:

Participants developed the capability to confidently approach and resolve intricate mathematical problems.



- To gain insight into social media optimization and search engine optimization.



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






Counselling on Skill Based Courses to be Offered in College

On 26th February 2022 the department of Physics organized an online workshop entitled "Program for Aspiring Women Scientists (PAWS)" conducted by Homi Bhabha Centre for Science Education & IPA'S Gender in Physics Working group on 'Combating Imposter Syndrome and biases

Eminent personalities from the field of Science and Research attended the workshop. This included Dr. Deepa Chari from Homi Bhabha Centre for Science Education, TIFR, and Professor Vandana Nanal from Tata Institute of Fundamental Research along with their team members Ms. Saurabi Huli and Ms. Bhagyashri Latad.

Objectives:

- · To provide a suitable learning environment to encourage women students to pursue a career in physics.
- To combat the imposter syndrome experienced by women scientists and create a supportive environment for them to overcome self-doubt and excel in their careers.
- To address the biases faced by women scientists in the field of physics and provide them with tools and strategies to navigate and overcome gender-based discrimination.
- The workshop was based on spreading awareness about imposter syndrome and unconscious biases and various ways to combat them. Topics like decision making, dealing with micro aggressions were also discussed. The faculty members along with students actively interacted with the team of Homi Bhabha centre for Science Education which further made the whole session more impactful. The workshop concluded with a short vote of thanks by the convener Dr. Sapna Sharma.

Outcomes: The program increased awareness among students about the phenomenon of imposter syndrome and biases, and their impact on their careers.








Dr. Abbas emphasized on effective communication, networking, and continuous learning to achieve career goals.


Outcome: The students gained valuable insights and strategies for effective career planning, emphasizing the importance of making informed choices based on their interests and abilities.






