

- ❖ The Third place was bagged by *Vaisuki* of English Honours 3rd year.



The competition was adjusted by Dr. Madhubala .After careful consideration and analysis, the following results were announced:


- ❖ First position : Gauri Negi (BA Passcourse 1st year)
