AN AWARENESS PROGRAM UNDER HAR GHAR TRIANGA CAMPAIGN

On August 14, 2022, the Department of History organized an awareness program as part of the Har Ghar Trianga campaign under the Azadi Ka Amrut Mahotsav, with the objective of invoking a sense of patriotism and promoting awareness among the people. The students of the Department of History conducted the program by approaching and interviewing members of the general public, asking them questions related to India's 75th anniversary of independence.

Objective: The awareness program aimed to invoke a feeling of patriotism in the hearts of the people and promote awareness about the significance of India's 75th anniversary.
