
**Description:** 

On March 19, 2025, St. Bede's College organized an orientation programme focused on raising awareness about equity in higher education for students from disadvantaged communities. The event was hosted by the Equal Opportunity Cell and the SC/ST Cell and featured Dr. Deepali Dhaul, Chairperson of the Department of English at Himachal Pradesh University (HPU) and Chief Advisor of the Equal Opportunity Cell at HPU, as the guest speaker. The session commenced at 11:00 AM and offered valuable insights into fostering equity and inclusion within academic institutions. Dr. Dhaul's address highlighted the University Grants Commission (UGC) guidelines aimed at promoting equal opportunities for students from marginalized backgrounds. She emphasized the importance of building an inclusive academic environment where students from all communities can access resources and opportunities without discrimination. Dr. Dhaul also stressed the need to enhance diversity among students, faculty, and staff, and to cultivate positive interpersonal relationships across social boundaries. She encouraged efforts to sensitize the academic community to the unique challenges faced by underrepresented groups and discussed strategies for overcoming social exclusion. Additionally, she informed students about UGC scholarships available for SC/ST and other marginalized communities, urging them to make full use of these opportunities.
