
#### Independence Day Celebration under the theme 'Har Ghar Tiranga': Day 3

**Date: August 15, 2024** 



First Place: Asha (B. Com 1st year)


Second Place: Devangi Sharma (Geography Honours 3rd Year)


#### Donation Drive on the occasion of "Sadbhavana Diwas"




Hindustan Scouts and Guides Praveshika Camp: Day 2


Hindustan Scouts and Guides Praveshika Camp: Day 3

Date: August 29, 2024










Photo Booth under Swachhata Pakhwada: Day 1 (September 13, 2024)






Date: September 14, 2024


Plantation Drive under the theme "Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam."


Pledge Against Drug Abuse under the theme "Nasha Mukt Bharat Abhiyan".










Pledge Against Drug Abuse under the theme "Nasha Mukt Bharat Abhiyan" (September 21, 2024)



Recycled Material Fashion Show under theme "Swachhata Hi Seva (SHS) 2024."


Date: October 1, 2024

#### **Gandhi Jayanti Celebration**


Date: October 2, 2024




Yoga Session in Celebration of Peace Day




