The members proposed and discussed various activities for the session, including:


- Cultural Festivals – Organizing heritage food festivals, folk performances, and traditional craft exhibitions.

- Competitions & Awareness Programs – Hosting essay, quiz etc. contests on heritage themes.




Agenda : Planning and Scheduling of Events for the World Heritage Week

- **25th November: Nukkad Natak** (1:30 PM, Courtyard) – A street play to highlight the importance of cultural heritage preservation.




